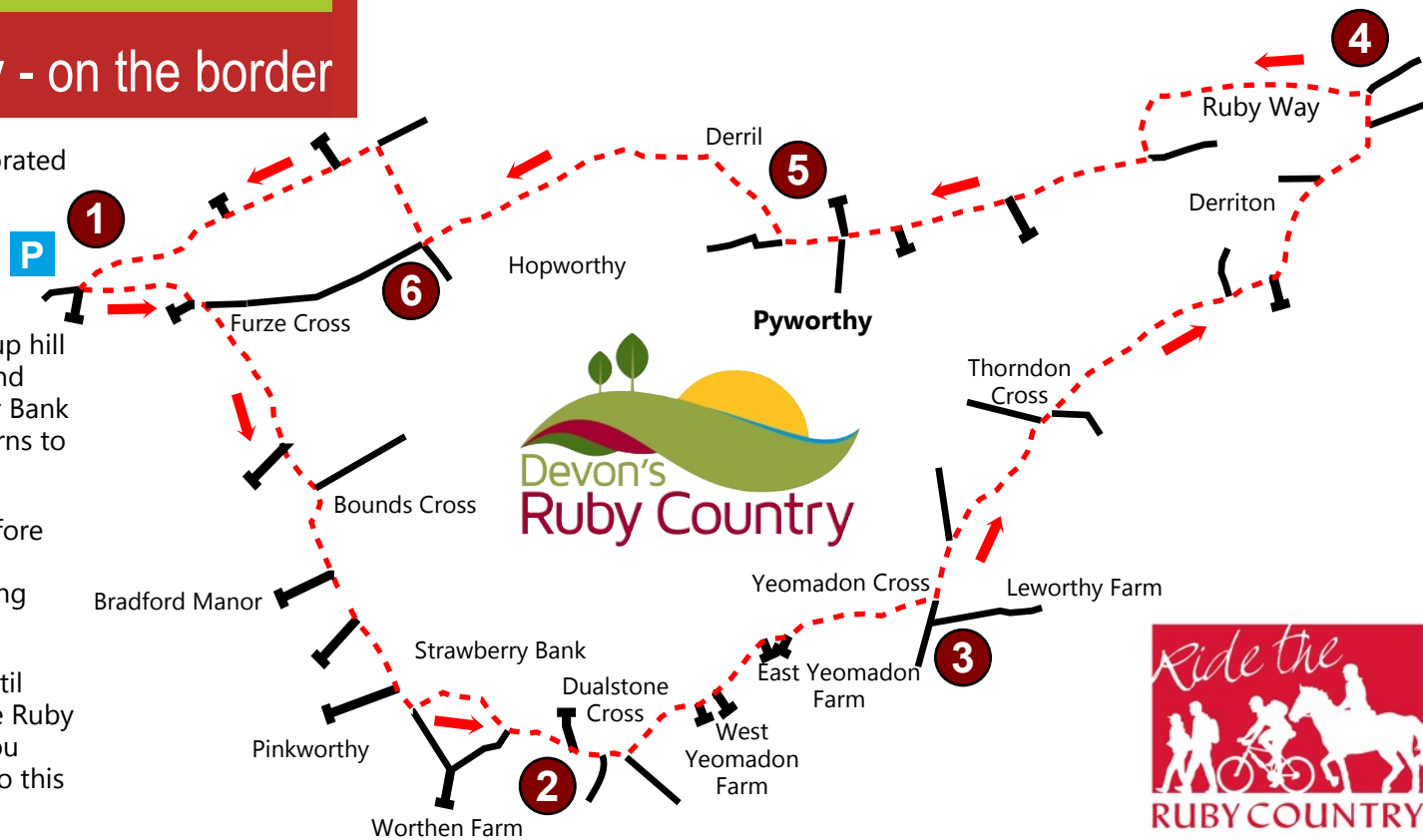


Western Ruby Country - on the border

This route can be combined with routes 2 and 4 or incorporated into a longer tour of Ruby Country using more of the cycle routes available to download from the website. It also links in to National Cycle Route 3 and can be extended from Bridgerule to Bude by following the signs.

- From the lay by beside the chapel in Bridgerule, head up hill away from the village. At the next junction turn right and follow the road through Bounds Cross, past Strawberry Bank and around a left hand bend followed by twists and turns to Dualstone Cross.
- Keep left and pass West and East Yeomadon Farms before coming to a T junction. This is the Holsworthy to North Tamerton road and can be busier than other roads being used.
- Turn left and keep on this road towards Holsworthy until Derriton Viaduct is reached. There is a sign here for the Ruby Way across the viaduct accessed via a spiral ramp. If you want to visit Holsworthy keep on the road and return to this point later.
- This route is also NCR 3. Follow the signs for NCR 3 to Pyworthy.
- If the pub is open in Pyworthy stop for refreshments. Follow the road out of Pyworthy in the direction of Bridgerule. Take the first road on the right through the hamlet of Derril and follow this road to the next crossroads. Turn right
- Follow this road to the T junction and turn left towards Bridgerule. Pass the church and then head steeply downhill. At the junction, with the Chapel on the right, turn right and then right again into the lay by from where the route started.

START/FINISH Grid reference SS276029

PARKING In the lay by beside the chapel in Bridgerule

FACILITIES Bridge Inn and shop in Bridgerule, Molesworth Arms in Pyworthy and all services and facilities in Holsworthy.
